All NEW Participants: All forms are due before you or your child may begin lessons. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Prior to the first lesson new participants **must** visit and schedule a student evaluation/pre acceptance. An instructor will make the evaluation. Please **call ahead** to make an appointment.

Current Participants: Please complete and return your **Student Packet** as soon as possible. Also you must complete and return a new CDBG form (one for Hemet and one for Riverside) every year. If you need a Scholarship, please call our office so that we can send you out the new packet to complete.

Waiting List: Returning Participants will be given priority registration, all other participants will be placed in an age/ability appropriate lesson on a first come first served basis.

Clothing: All participants **must wear long pants and closed toed shoes** and wear an **ASTM approved horseback riding helmet**. All personal helmets must be checked by a certified instructor. T.H.E. Center will have helmets available for use.

Lessons: Group Therapy lessons are one (1) hour long including mounting and dismounting. Individual lessons are thirty (30) minutes long including mounting and dismounting. Group General Public Lessons are one and one half (1 1/2) hours long including mounting and dismounting. Individual General Public lessons are one (1) hour including mounting and dismounting. Riding time may vary due to the individual needs of each student, class size and volunteer availability. Class time may also include grooming and basic horsemanship.

Inclement Weather: If too hot, too cold, too windy, too wet, too rainy, icy, etc. classes **will be held indoors**. Class will include basic horsemanship and various activities to improve learning and skills.

FEES - Fees are due on the first lesson of each month. If you need special arrangements please contact Sonya Haffner. Monthly billing will go out on the 5th of each month. **Fees are monthly whether you ride or not.** Classes are scheduled in advance per month.

NO CALL/NO SHOW – this is an additional fee: Please call by 8:00 AM morning of class if not attending class. If you **DO NOT CALL/NO SHOW you will be charged an additional No Show No Call Fee of \$15.00.** After three (3) no call/no show, you will be dropped from the class and put on the waiting list. Also if you are on a scholarship, you will be removed from the scholarship program and will have to re-apply for scholarship.
